

Grace Church Safe Ministry Incident Management Process

Grace Church's policy is that:

- All training is delivered online at: <https://gracechurchbv.safeministrycheck.com.au/>
- All Grace Church attendees are encouraged to complete the free online awareness course every 12 months.
- Everyone on any roster (including music, coffee, and welcoming) should:
 - complete the online Safe Ministry's Volunteer's Course prior to serving,
 - sign a code of conduct (it pops up at the end of the online course), and
 - provide the relevant screening checks (these are collected by the online system)
- Everyone should refresh their online training every 12 months.

We do this to:

- Become a safe community able to recognise vulnerable people.
- Be able to recognise the risks and signs of possible abuse within our community (physical, sexual, psychological, neglect and fraud).
- Know who to approach if there are concerns.

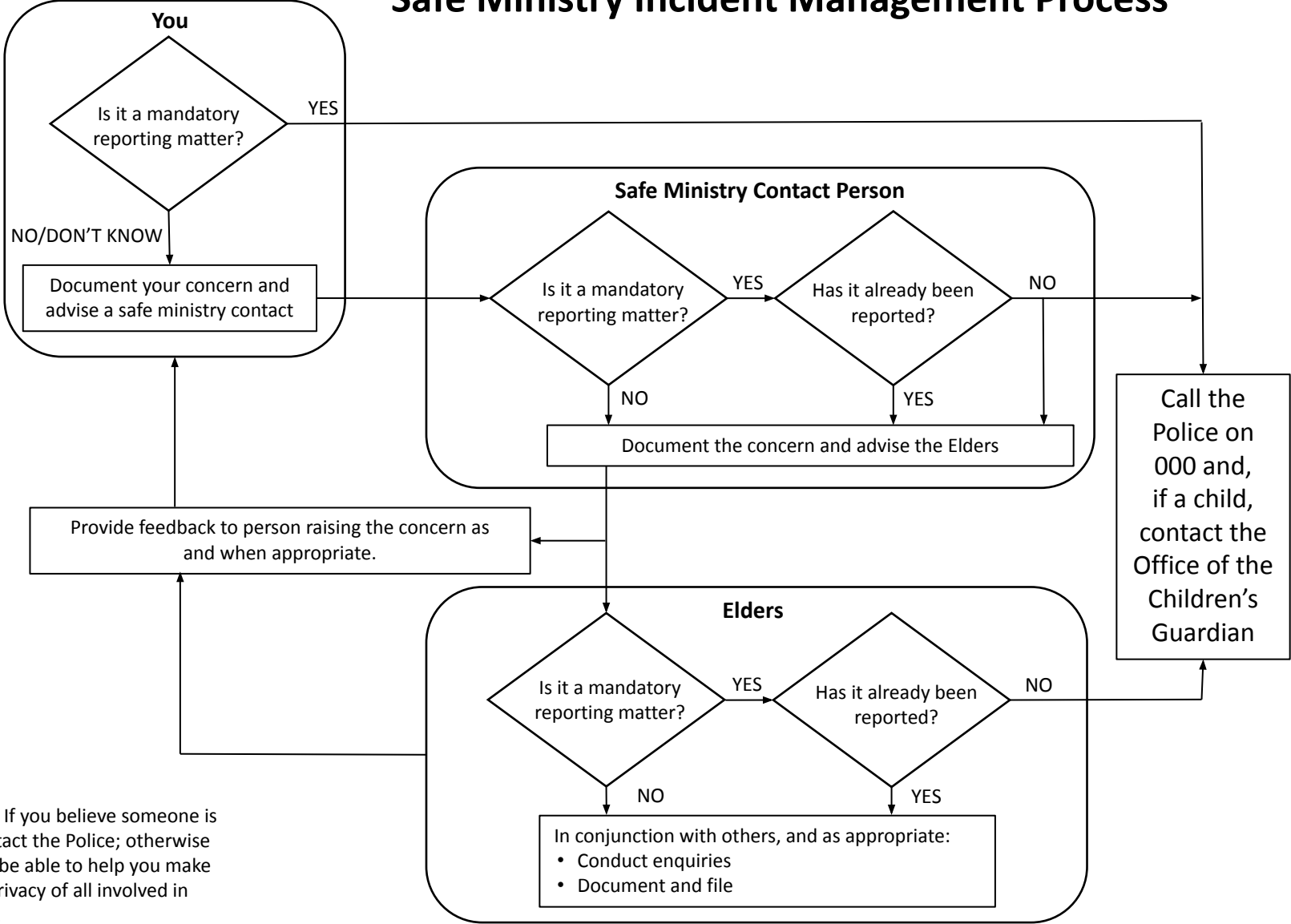

How do I raise a concern about the safety of someone in a Grace Church program or a concern about how a volunteer or leader at Grace Church has behaved?



All Concerns must be reported. If you believe someone is at risk of immediate harm, contact the Police; otherwise your Safe Ministry Contact will be able to help you make a report. Please maintain the privacy of all involved in any matter under investigation.
